Our Mission

Our ministry fills the gap that often exists for families that are receiving great medical care inside the walls of a hospital and the unique needs of oncology and hematology patients outside of those walls. Issues such as compromised immunity eliminate the ability to stay in communal living situations like a hotel. The extensive length of treatment often creates significant financial burdens on families who are required to remain in close proximity to the hospital. aTeam Ministries was created to fill those gaps that present unique challenges to families facing pediatric cancer.



Foundation & Programs

SPIRITUAL

Prayer Team: Provides an opportunity for supporters of *aTeam* to gather on a weekly basis to pray for patients and their families. During 2019, our prayer team prayed for 267 children by name.

FINANCIAL

Home Away From Home: Families from all over Alabama travel hours to Birmingham for treatment. aTeam's Home Away from Home program consists of two apartments in close proximity to Children's of Alabama, providing local extended lodging to families battling pediatric cancer: rent-free. These private apartments are specifically cleaned, furnished, and maintained for children undergoing treatment.

How We Can Help-Financial Grants: This program provides grants to families in critical financial need. Grants are provided through an application process and provide direct-to-vendor payments for the following needs: rent/mortgage and other household utility expenses; medical treatment expenses; and funeral expenses.

Christmas Sponsorships: During the holiday season, sponsors "adopt" families battling pediatric cancer, providing Christmas gifts and seasonal cheer to ease the pressure on parents working to make Christmas special for their family amidst the chaos of pediatric cancer.

EMOTIONAL

Go Gold: Seeks to raise awareness for pediatric cancer and its symbol: The gold ribbon.

Hope Lives On: Walking with Families as they journey through the grief of losing a child to pediatric cancer.

Special Events: Host events celebrating occasions such as completion of chemotherapy.

aConnect: Links volunteers with pediatric cancer families to lovingly provide for their needs.

Encouragement Cards:

For birthdays, holidays, or a simple pick-me-up, aTeam volunteers write hundreds of cards for patients each year to remind them that they have a community of support right by their side!

Fundraising

CLAYS4KIDS

Clays4Kids is a clay-shooting event that serves as a great opportunity to make memories with friends while supporting aTeam as well as a great outlet for patient families to enjoy time together away from the hospital.

18 FOR ATEAM

18 for aTeam is our annual golf tournament, held at the Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail at Oxmoor Valley in Birmingham. Patients and survivors often join us for tee time as honorary starters along with teams of dads who play in honor of their sons or daughters diagnosed with cancer.

2019-2020 Highlights

- » aTeam elebrated 10 years of ministry in December 2019.

- » 623 restful nights were provided to patient families in our Home Away from Home apartments.
- \$23,169 in financial assistance was given to families facing pediatric cancer throughout Alabama.
- 267 children were prayed for by name.
- » 12 survivors were celebrated at Champions of Chemo.
- 74 tickets were distributed through our Day at Game program.
- 3 10 families were sponsored through our Christmas Sponsorships.

aTeam's largest event of the year, heart2heart is an exciting evening crafted to celebrate pediatric cancer patients and raise support for aTeam Ministries. Pediatric cancer patients are paired with professional artists to create unique works of art, which are auctioned off at the event.

SHOAL CREEK SHOOTOUT




2019-2020 Goals


- » Share the love of Christ with patient families as we support new and existing families.
