

aTeam Ministries is a 501(c)(3) organization committed to offering spiritual, emotional, and financial support to children and their families within the pediatric cancer community. This support is given with the desire to live out the scriptural truth found in 2 Corinthians 1:3-4.

Our ministry fills the gap that often exists for families that are receiving great medical care inside the walls of a hospital and the unique needs of oncology and hematology patients outside of those walls. Issues such as compromised immunity eliminate the ability to stay in communal living situations like a hotel. The extended length of treatment often creates great financial burdens on families who are required to remain in close proximity to the hospital. aTeam Ministries was created to fill those gaps that present unique challenges to families facing pediatric cancer.

In addition to the families we've reached in Alabama, aTeam Ministries has also been blessed to extend our ministry beyond state lines to pray for families in TN, GA, MS, LA, FL, SC, VA, IL, PA, NY, WI, CO, MI, and WA!

PRAYER TEAM

Since the start of our ministry, aTeam has made it a priority to pray for our patient families. The aTeam Prayer Team provides an opportunity for supporters of our ministry to gather once a month at our office to pray for patients and families by name. The aTeam prayer journal is updated weekly with specific needs of patients, and it is emailed out every Monday for those who cannot attend prayer time.

aTeam Scholarship

In 2021, aTeam Ministries introduced a new scholarship program for childhood cancer survivors! A one-time \$2,500 scholarship is awarded to a survivor to help offset the cost of furthering their education. We're excited to announce that in 2022 we will expand this program to include an additional \$2,500 scholarship, awarded to a sibling of a pediatric cancer patient!

Home Away from Home

Families from all over Alabama travel hours to Birmingham for treatment. aTeam's Home Away from Home program consists of two apartments in close proximity to Children's of Alabama that provide extended lodging to families battling pediatric cancer, rent-free. These private apartments are specifically cleaned, furnished, and maintained for children undergoing treatment.

This year, we were able to provide some much-needed updates to both of our Home Away from Home units. These updates included

new household items such as a sofa, end tables, coffee tables, rugs, lamps, artwork, and bedding. Through generous donations, we were also able to purchase new TVs for each apartment. These updates help to make the apartments light, bright and welcoming to those who walk through the doors.

aTeam's Home Away from Home program hosted 9 families who needed to remain close to the hospital during treatment.







Christmas Sponsorships

During the holiday season, volunteers and community groups "adopt" families battling pediatric cancer. Sponsors provide Christmas gifts and additional seasonal cheer to ease the financial pressure for parents working to make Christmas special for their child diagnosed with pediatric cancer and his/her siblings.

Financial Assistance


aTeam extends grants to families in critical financial need, providing financial grants as direct-to-vendor payments, such as paying a bill directly to the utility company. Individual families are able to receive up to \$1,000 of assistance each year.

\$16,395.67 in financial assistance was distributed to aTeam patient families.

aTeam provided 8 families with "Journeying through Grief" booklets.




Fundraising <


Share the love of Christ with patient families as we support new and existing families known by our ministry.


