### **DATES TO KNOW:**

Applications will be available February 1, 2025.

Applications will be due March 21, 2025.

Interviews will be held for those selected for the second round at the beginning of April 2025.

Scholarships will be announced May 2025.

Recipients must be able to attend an award luncheon in June, date to be determined.

# **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. Applicants must be a cancer survivor under the age of 25 and diagnosed before the age of 18 with cancer.
- 2. Applicants must be a US citizen.
- 3. Applicants must be attending an accredited college, university or vocational institution in the fall.
- 4. Preference will be given to patients previously known or assisted by aTeam Ministries.
- 5. If you have previously applied and not received the scholarship, aTeam invites you to apply once again.
