Applications will be available February 1, 2026.

Applications will be due March 20, 2026.

Interviews will be held for those selected for the second round in April/May 2026

Recipients must be able to attend an award luncheon in June, date to be determined.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Applicants must be the sibling of a cancer patient. The applicant must be under the age of 25 and their siblings must have been diagnosed before the age of 18.
2. Applicants must be a US citizen.
3. Applicants must be attending an accredited college, university, or vocational institution in the fall.
4. Preference will be given to patient siblings previously known or assisted by aTeam Ministries.
